

## **UNIFORM/DRESS CODE**

Uniforms are used to promote unity and equity to all students.

## Benefits of uniforms:

- Decreases bullying
- Inspires a sense of professionalism in students
- Increases Safety
- Easier morning for parents and students
- Builds school spirit and pride

## Girls Uniform policies:

## Hair and Nails:

- Hair is neat and combed nicely
- Students are not allowed to dye their hair any natural or unnatural hair color are prohibited (no greens, reds, blues, purples, yellows, oranges, etc.)
- Free forming hair, braids, dreads are prohibited
- Hair is to be pulled out of the face,
- Bangs above the eyebrows are allowed
- All types of artificial nails are prohibited
- Natural nails are to be no longer than the tip of the finger (this is for safety)
- Only biological girls are allowed to paint their nails

### Shoes:

# Allowed shoe colors are: navy blue, black, grey, and brown

## Styles of shoes:

- Tennis shoes
- Flat Mary Jane shoes with strap
- Boots below the knee, pants must be pulled over the boot
- Uggs cannot be worn with skirts, skorts, nor shorts



 Opened-toe shoes, heels, wedges, crocs, thigh boots, house slippers, Skele-toes are not school-approved footwear

# Jewelry:

- Minimal Jewelry: Students are encouraged to wear minimal jewelry to maintain focus and prevent distractions in the classroom.
- Necklaces: Long chains are not permitted. If students choose to wear necklaces, they should be short and simple.
- Earrings:
  - o Girls: Only stud earrings are allowed. Dangly or hoop earrings are not permitted.
  - Boys: Earrings are not allowed.

Other Jewelry: Any other jewelry, such as bracelets and rings, should be simple and not excessive.

# Dresscode:

Order uniforms from Cookies Uniforms:

All shirts are required to have the LCA crest

- Gray or navy blue slacks
- Gray or navy blue skirts and skort
- Skirts may be worn with solid black leggings/ tights (no lace trim or mesh) that go to the ankle. Leg
- warmers and loud or contrasting colors of pantyhose or socks are not acceptable. No designs may be woven into the material.
- LCA jumper
- LCA plaid tie

### **Chapel Uniforms**

Chapel uniforms must be worn every Wednesday or on other days designated by the school.

• **Girls:** Plaid jumper *or* blue skirt, white blouse (not a polo), and school plaid tie.



# **Boys Uniform Policies**

#### Hair and Nails:

- Hair is neat and combed nicely
- Students are not allowed to dye their hair any natural or unnatural hair color are prohibited (no greens, reds, blues, purples, yellows, oranges, etc.)
- Free-forming hair, braids, or dreads are prohibited
- Hair is to be pulled out of the face

### Shoes:

# Allowed shoe colors are: navy blue, black, grey, and brown

- Opened-toe or open heel shoes, heels, wedges, crocs, thigh high boots, house slippers, and Skele-toes are not school-approved footwear

## Dresscode:

- LCA white dress shirt

# **Chapel Uniforms**

Chapel uniforms must be worn every Wednesday or on other days designated by the school.

• **Boys:** White button-up school shirt with crest, blue slacks, school plaid tie, and school blazer.

## JEAN DAYS

Every Friday, students are allowed to wear jean bottoms and a school SPirited Shirt for \$1. Jeans must be

blue or black and have no rips or holes in them. Jeans must be touching the knee.

## Outwear

Uniforms, sweatshirts, and cardigans must have the LCA crest on them. Outerwear not complying with

LCA policy will not be allowed and should be taken off when entering the building.
